Incentives – Through the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Kentucky Economic Development Finance Authority (KEDFA) and Northern Kentucky local communities, a variety of available incentives is offered to qualified companies.

- Kentucky Business Investment (KBI) tax credits for job creation
- Kentucky Reinvestment Act (KRA) tax incentives for new or expanding operations
- Kentucky Enterprise Funds and the Kentucky Department of Commercialization and Innovation – assistance for fast-growth, high-tech companies through grants/loans
- Kentucky Enterprise Initiative Act (KEIA) sales and use tax refunds on building materials
- Bluegrass Training Skills investment credits for skills training projects
