Economic Development Rate (EDR)

The EDR program offers rate discounts to eligible business customers who would not remain in, expand, or locate their operations in California but for the EDR discount, either on its own or in combination with other incentives. Subject to calculations specified in the applicable EDR tariff, qualified businesses may receive up to a 12% discount on their electricity rate for a five-year period.

"Shovel-Ready" Sites Pilot Program

EDS sponsored the Shovel-Ready Sites Pilot Program, offering qualified, certified land sites that are virtually "shovel-ready" and relatively riskfree. Now, the certification of a site is performed by the California Department of Real Estate (DRE), who will review required materials to ensure a site meets specific criteria including, but not limited to, verification and availability of utilities, site access, environmental concerns, land use conformance, and potential site development costs. In Southern California, there is one certified site:

• Town of Apple Valley Certified Site Apple Valley offers an 80-acre site located within the town's recently formed North Apple Valley Industrial-Specific Plan Area.

Economic Impact Analysis (ECIA)

ECIA provides valuable information for businesses, local government, community planners, economic development agencies, chambers of commerce and service organizations. Through targeted analysis, ECIA demonstrates a company's potential by forecasting incremental revenue streams to the city, county and state, increased employment, and regional economic output.
