Choosing the right location for your business is one of the most important decisions when starting or expanding a company. The Cape Coral-Fort Myers MSA ranks as the No. 6 fastest-growing metro areas in the U.S. (*Money Watch*, 2015). You owe it to your enterprise to find out what Cape Coral has to offer.



Nearly 75% of Florida's population is within 160 miles of Cape Coral. The region's award-winning Southwest Florida International Airport (RSW) is within 15 miles, the Page Field Aviation Center is just five miles away and the Punta Gorda Airport is approximately 10 miles north of Cape Coral.

The city is also within 10 miles of Interstate 75 for connecting northward to Tampa and on to the Midwestern states, and southeastward to Miami/Fort Lauderdale. U.S. Route 41 (which runs from Miami to the Upper Peninsula of Michigan) connects into the city.

At 120 square miles, Cape Coral is the third largest city in Florida by landmass. With a regional population of about 1.2 million, Southwest Florida is steadily gaining as a significant contributory market, which makes Cape Coral poised to be a driver for the region's economic growth.

Cape Coral is one of the largest master-planned communities in the nation with modern infrastructure systems in place and expanding. Regulators recognize the city's reverse osmosis plant and dual-water system as among the most progressive in the nation. The dual-water irrigation system provides homeowners and business owners with extremely low cost irrigation water—another money-saver for employers who relocate to Cape Coral.

The Cape boasts a robust communications infrastructure, including Century Link, a 100% fiber optic SONET ring and Comcast cable. By one analysis, Cape Coral has broadband capacity several times greater than that of larger Florida cities.

Cape Coral is well served with the essential utilities, roads and telecommunications resources needed to support growth. Traffic flows easily on our established roadways and extensive broadband and fiber optics provide an easy global reach.
