## **Globally Connected**

Greenspoint's central location is attractive to companies doing business internationally. The Port of Houston, ranked first in the U.S. for foreign waterborne tonnage, is within 30 minutes of Greenspoint via the Sam Houston Parkway. George Bush Intercontinental Airport, six miles east of Greenspoint, serves 31 countries and has the most nonstop flights to Mexico. Bush's 61,000 square-foot fresh air cargo center is a distribution point to markets across the United States. The City of Houston is home to the nation's third largest consular corps, 22 foreign banks from 12 nations, 30 active international chambers of commerce and trade associations, numerous foreign-owned companies, and is one of only eight U.S. cities to have a regional office of the U.S. Export-Import Bank.




