



# Labor Pool Summary

## Houston - Greenspoint District

Houston is a sprawling city encompassing 628 square miles. The city's labor pool is drawn from the Houston Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA), a 10-county region. The average time commuters spend driving to work in the Houston MSA is 28 minutes. To examine the potential labor pool for businesses located in Houston's Greenspoint District, the data below describes the workers living within 31 minutes of the District.

Based on total population of 3,131,689 within 31-minute drive time of Greenspoint District




Greenspoint's close proximity to major freeways allows access to a vast labor pool within 31 minutes.






The Greenspoint District's 6,700 businesses employ 65,000 workers. The following information relates to those employees.

### Jobs by Earnings


Greenspoint has a greater proportion of high income earners (57.5%) than Texas (38.7%).
