
Logistics

Goochland County provides a central location on a regional and national level. Located in Central Virginia, and west of the Richmond metro, Goochland serves as a regional business and retail hub for the east coast. Proximity to a major international airport allows goods and freight to reach 50 percent of the United States in 24 hours. Interstate 64 runs for 30 miles of Goochland County, and connects two major metros.

Additionally, the Richmond International Airport (RIC), is located in Foreign Trade Zone #207 just 20 miles south east of Goochland County. RIC handles more than 140 million pounds of cargo annually. The RIC cargo facility currently offers 750,000 square feet of storage space. With such impressive transportation infrastructure and connectivity, Goochland County is an ideal location for companies on the move.
